The present study dealt at finding out the correlation between self-confidence and English speaking skill of the eighth grade students of SMPN 1 Blahbatuh in academic year 2021/2022, the variables of this study were students' self-confidence and English speaking skill. Based on the result, it was shown that .321 was in interval low correlation between self-confidence and English speaking skill.
